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1. SECTION 1 - GENERAL

The Belly Utility Mount consists of the installation of a frame system attached to existing mounting points. The mount can accommodate systems not to exceed 1.84 square feet combined spherical and cylindrical frontal flat plate area and a weight of 80 pounds. The mount is designed to accommodate antennas and similar equipment.
